

# NOTICE OF CURFEW



### Ordinance 3-1.1

### **Definitions**

"Guardian" shall mean the parent of the juvenile, a person other than a parent to whom legal custody of the juvenile has been given by court order or who is acting in the place of the parent or is responsible for the care and welfare of the juvenile.

"Juvenile" shall mean an individual who is under the age of 18.

"Public place" shall mean any place to which the public has access, including but not limited to a public street, road, thoroughfare, sidewalk, bridge, alley, plaza, park, recreation or shopping area, public transportation facility, vehicle used for public transportation, parking lot or any other public building, structure or area.

### Ordinance 3-1.2 Curfew Established

It shall be a violation of this chapter for any juvenile to be in a public place between the hours of 10:00 p.m. - 6:00 a.m. Sunday through Friday, 11:00 p.m. - 6:00 a.m. Friday through Sunday, prevailing time, unless accompanied by the juvenile's guardian or unless engaged in or traveling to or from a business or occupation which the laws of the state authorize a juvenile to perform.

# Ordinance 3-1.4 Guardian Responsibility

It shall be a violation of this chapter for a guardian of a juvenile to allow that juvenile to be in a public place during 10:00 p.m. - 6:00 a.m. Sunday through Friday, 11:00 p.m. - 6:00 a.m. Friday through Sunday, prevailing time, subject to the exemptions of subsection 3-1.2 and 3-1.3.

## Ordinance 3-1.5 Violations

Any violations of this chapter shall be prosecuted in the Pine Hill Municipal Court. Upon finding of guilt, the municipal court shall impose a sentence of community service and a fine not to exceed one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars. If both a juvenile and that juvenile's guardian violate this chapter, they shall be required to perform community service together.
